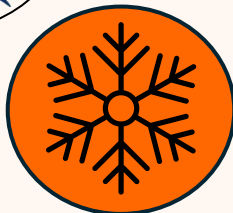


PREPARE FOR WEATHER RELATED EMERGENCIES IN NEW LONDON, CT
