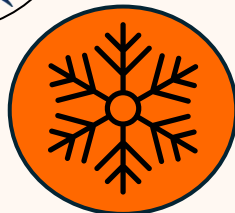


PREPARE FOR WEATHER RELATED EMERGENCIES IN STAMFORD, CT

Are you signed up to receive emergency alerts?

Do you know how to prepare for weather emergencies like hurricanes, flooding, ice and extreme heat?

Fill in your location and preferred alert type (text, email, app, phone). This alert system will notify you of extreme weather events and provide shelter and evacuation information.

WHAT TO DO DURING EXTREME EVENTS

Cooling and Warming Centers

HURRICANES and FLOOD EVACUATION INFORMATION

Find Your Zone (Hurricane Evacuation Zones):

evacuation maps CT](#)". Click on "Interactive Know your Zone Evacuation Map Tool," then click on "Find Your Zone" and put in your address to find out if you live or work in Evacuation Zone A or B.

Stamford public emergency shelter for flood evacuation or major power outage emergency:

Stamford High School, 55 Strawberry Hill Avenue. **Always check City of Stamford website or call Hotline at 203-977-8840 to make sure shelter is open.** Residents may bring personal belongings, pets, pet food, and leashes.
