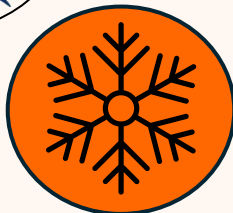


PREPARE FOR WEATHER RELATED EMERGENCIES IN WEST HAVEN, CT
